



INTRODUCTION





FDOT PROGRAM MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- Promote further development and improvement of air routes, airport facilities, and landing fields and protect their approaches and stimulate the development of aviation commerce and air facilities
- Prepare and update aviation/airport work program to include proposed local sponsor projects
- Provide funding to airports based on statutory requirements
- Support development of airport land with objective of helping airport to be fiscally self-supporting



FDOT FIVE-YEAR WORK PROGRAM

- A rolling five-year plan to maximize FDOT's production
 & service
- Includes the following components:
 - Preliminary Tentative Work Program
 - Tentative Work Program
 - Adopted Work Program
